**SUBJECT:** Confirmation of 2023-2024 Weed Abatement Charges

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The City Council will consider:

1. Conducting a Public Hearing
2. Confirming the 2026 Weed Abatement Charges as recommended by the Los Angeles County Agricultural Commission

### **ANALYSIS:**

Annually, the County of Los Angeles Agricultural Commission prepares a list of properties containing noxious or dangerous weeds and rubbish and the associated costs of abating such nuisances. The individual property owners affected are notified of the necessity of removing identified weeds or rubbish. In those instances where the property owner does not want to assume responsibility for abatement, the Agricultural Commission Weed Abatement Division does the work and charges the property owner. A three-year period is allowed for any appeal of the charges. Notification, hearing, and appeal procedures are conducted according to the California Government Code.

In order to proceed with this year's program, the City Council must confirm the 2026 Weed Abatement Charges. The Weed Abatement charges have been posted for public viewing and are attached hereto for review.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This activity can be carried out without additional impact on the current operating budget.
