A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING THE APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26

WHEREAS, Chapter 1205 of the Statutes of 1980, effective January 1, 1981, implemented Article XIII B of the California Constitution, which establishes an annual appropriations limit for local governments; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 111, approved by the voters in 1990, amended Article XIII B to modify the factors used in calculating the annual appropriations limit, allowing local jurisdictions to use a combination of population change and either the change in California per capita personal income or the change in the local assessment roll due to nonresidential new construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 2025–26 is established at \$252,763,021 and the appropriation subject to limitation is \$131,336,500 as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
