**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA,
ESTABLISHING THE APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26**

WHEREAS, Chapter 1205 of the Statutes of 1980, effective January 1, 1981, implemented Article XIII B of the California Constitution, which establishes an annual appropriations limit for local governments; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 111, approved by the voters in 1990, amended Article XIII B to modify the factors used in calculating the annual appropriations limit, allowing local jurisdictions to use a combination of population change and either the change in California per capita personal income or the change in the local assessment roll due to non-residential new construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 2025–26 is established at \$252,763,021 and the appropriation subject to limitation is \$131,336,500 as shown in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

EXHIBIT "A"
ARTICLE XIII-B CALCULATIONS
FOR
FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2025-26

Per Capita Change = 6.44%¹ (Personal Income)
Population Change = 0.30%

Per Capita converted to a ratio: $(6.44 + 100) / 100 = 1.0644$

Population converted to a ratio: $(0.30 + 100) / 100 = 1.0030$

Calculation of factor for FY 2025-26: $1.0644 \times 1.0030 = 1.0675$
