**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA,

WHEREAS, the attached salary schedule reflects all current salaries, including Council-approved and negotiated changes, and is consistent with the City's budget and labor agreements; and

WHEREAS, adopting this salary schedule ensures compliance with CalPERS and supports transparent compensation practices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Commerce hereby adopts the Fiscal Year 2025-26 salary schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", "B", and "C" and incorporated by reference.
