SUBJECT: Weed Abatement Resolution

MEETING DATE: February 8, 2022

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Resolution declaring that weeds, etc. on or in front of specified properties on the City is a public nuisance and declaring intention to abate same, and assign the number next in order.

ANALYSIS:

The proposed Resolution declares that weeds, brush, rubbish and refuse upon or in front of specified property in the City are a seasonal and recurrent public nuisance. It also declares that the City intends to provide for the abatement of such nuisance on the properties identified by the County of Los Angeles, Agricultural Commission of Weight and Measure's Office.

The proposed Resolution designates for the Hearing of Protests against the action of the City Council to abate the seasonal and recurrent public nuisance. The Los Angeles County Agricultural Commissioner/Director of Weights and Measures mailed notices, as required by the Government Code, to the affected property owners.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with this agenda item.

RELATIONSHIP TO STRATEGIC GOALS:

This activity is an annual program carried out by the County of Los Angeles on behalf of the City and is related to 2016 Strategic Goal, "Community Quality of Life" and Guiding Principle 5 - "Continue to identify and develop City Codes that support a clean, well-maintained and sustainable community."
