## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A RATE ADJUSTMENT REQUEST BY ATHENS SERVICES FOR RESIDENTIAL REFUSE AND RECYCLING SERVICES

**WHEREAS**, on July 1, 2014, the City approved an agreement with CalMet Services Inc. for residential refuse and recycling services; with an expiration date of June 30, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 16, 2018, the City approved a First Amendment to the agreement for residential refuse and recycling services; with an expiration date of June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2022, Athens Services acquired CalMet and issued notification letters to residents; and

**WHEREAS,** on January 17, 2023, Athens submitted a letter to the City requesting an extension of the agreement, which was set to expire on June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2023, Athens submitted a letter to the City requesting a CPI-based rate adjustment of 6.19%. The increase was effective July 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2023, the City approved a Second Amendment to the agreement for residential refuse and recycling services. It included provisions for an annual review process for rate adjustments, a monthly cost of \$91,726.41 for residential units, an annual rate adjustment based on the Trash CPI plus one percent (1%), an extension of the agreement through June 30, 2028; with an option for a one-time five-year extension commencing July 1, 2028; and

**WHERAS,** on April 12, 2024, Athens submitted a letter to the City requesting a CPIbased rate adjustment of 7.05%. The Increase was effective July 1, 2024; and

**WHEREAS,** per the Second Amendment to Athens' agreement, Athens may request a rate adjustment plus one percent (1%) annually in writing prior to April 15<sup>th</sup> for the period commencing the following July 1<sup>st</sup>. Any adjustment shall not be effective unless approved by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> All of the recitals above are true and correct and incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

<u>Section 2.</u> Approve a rate 6.14% rate adjustment for solid waste collection services to become effective July 1, 2025.

<u>Section 3.</u> Authorize the Mayor to execute the Resolution for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
