CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chair Rodriguez called meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.

Gloria Nezahualcoyotl and Guille Reyes expressed their support for Item #2 on the agenda, which pertains to the approval of public safety camera trailers.

SCHEDULED MATTERS

1. Approval of the Meeting Minutes of Wednesday, June 26, 2024

Committee Member Grajeda moved, seconded by Committee Member Rendon, to approve the Munites of June 26, 2024. The motion was carried by the following vote:

2. <u>Public Safety Camera Trailers</u>

Public Safety Manager Edson provided an overview of the staff report and recommended that the City lease three public safety camera trailers for a 12-month period at a cost of \$82,468, rather than purchasing them outright. Manager Edson explained that because the technology is new and rapidly evolving, leasing allows the City to test the program before making a long-term investment. He noted that the trailers have proven to be effective crime deterrents and reported that other

cities using similar trailers have expressed satisfaction with their performance, with no complaints received.

In response to concerns about potential damage to the trailers, Manager Edson clarified that the lease cost includes repairs and coverage for any damages incurred.

Additional discussion was held regarding Deputy and Community Service Officer (CSO) coverage and services. The placement of the trailers would be guided by a "heat map" to identify areas with the greatest need for enhanced public safety measures.

Committee Member Grajeda moved, and Committee Member Rendon seconded, to acquire the public safety camera trailers and recommend inclusion of the associated costs in the Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Public Safety budget to be presented to the City Council for approval. The motion was carried by the following vote:
