ORDINANCES

1. <u>Urgency Interim Ordinance -Temporary Moratorium on Home-Sharing and Vacation Rentals</u>

Director of Community Development Serrano provided an overview of the staff report. Discussion followed regarding the effective date of the ordinance, should it pass, and when Code Enforcement could begin enforcement. According to City Attorney Tapia, the ordinance would take effect immediately upon adoption and remain in effect for 45 days. City staff will return with a follow-up report outlining actions taken and whether an extension is warranted. If needed, the ordinance may be extended a second time for an additional 45 days, and a third time for up to one year for this moratorium.

Councilmember Rebollo moved, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Lainez, to introduce and adopt Ordinance establishing citywide 45-day an The motion moratorium on home-sharing and vacation rental uses. was carried by the following vote:
