A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES PROBATION DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE A PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION PROGRAM (PIP) FOR JULY 1, 2025 -JUNE 30, 2026

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce engages the Los Angeles County Probation Department to provide a Prevention and Intervention Program (PIP); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide probation prevention and intervention services to assist in reducing incidents of truancy, delinquency and other serious behavioral problems, and monitoring of adults on probation; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement between City of Commerce and L.A. County Probation Department has been in existence since 1987; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Probation Officer has been delegated authority by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors to negotiate and sign agreements to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in a joint effort with the county;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES, DECLARES AND DETERMINES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council of the City of Commerce hereby finds and declares that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and incorporates them herein as findings and as a substantive part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2.</u> The County of Los Angeles Probation Department Agreement to Provide a Prevention and Intervention Program (PIP) for July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026, at a cost of \$127,000, not including any adjustments to salary, employee benefits and/or overhead rates approved by the Board of Supervisors during the fiscal year, is hereby approved with respect to the level of services.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor is authorized to execute the Agreement and this Resolution for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
