SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF A COUNCIL MEMBER TO THE GREATER LOS ANGELES COUNTY VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES

MEETING DATE: June 23, 2026

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the appointment of Mayor Pro Tem Mireya Garcia as the City of Commerce representative to the Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District Board of Trustees.

BACKGROUND:

The Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District (GLACVCD) is governed by a Board of Trustees comprised of representatives appointed by its member cities and agencies. The City of Commerce is entitled to appoint a representative to serve on the Board and participate in matters related to mosquito and vector control programs, public health initiatives, and district governance.

The City Council's organizational assignments are reviewed periodically and may be modified as needed. The Council Member previously assigned to this position did not wish to serve in this capacity. As a result, the position is currently vacant and requires a City Council appointment to ensure the City of Commerce maintains representation on the District Board.

Mayor Pro Tem Mireya Garcia has expressed an interest in serving on the Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District Board of Trustees and is willing to represent the City of Commerce. Staff recommends the appointment of Mayor Pro Tem Garcia to fill the vacancy and serve as the City's representative.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action. Any related meeting attendance may be accommodated within the existing operating budget.
