CALTRANS REQUIREMENTS

Gateway Monuments

- Less than or equal to 353 cubic feet
- Less than or equal to 20' wide and 18' high (above finish grade)
- Located vertically 8' above or 52' horizontally from the finish surface of traveled way (1-5 south)
- Must be freestanding structure

Landscaping


- All trees removed must be replaced
- Plant materials to be drought tolerant and reduce urban heat island effect

DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

- Preserve view of Steven's Steakhouse sign from 1-5 northbound freeway.
- Orient GM toward primary audience (I-5 north)
- GM placement to extend viewing corridor as far as possible while minimizing tree removal
- Sign letters to be as large as possible given maximum width of 20'
- GM lighting and material colors to not distract drivers or resemble traffic light and signage colors




