A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A HEAVY-DUTY COMMERCIAL TIRE CHANGER AND ACCESSORY EQUIPMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000

WHEREAS, Staff recommend that the City Council adopt a resolution to approve the purchase of a heavy-duty commercial tire changer and accessory equipment in an amount not to exceed \$100,000, utilizing the State of California, Purchasing Contract No 7-23-99-48-01; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce was awarded a \$100,000 grant (CA-2023-034-02-01) from the Federal Transit Administrator (FTA) for the purchase of bus service operating equipment for the City's transit fleet. This capital grant allows the City to purchase operating equipment using capital grant funds; and

WHEREAS, The State of California's contract documents comply with all the requirements set by the State, Federal Transit Administration, and the City for competitive procurement. The Transportation staff have determined that purchasing this heavy-duty commercial tire changer and equipment is of the utmost importance for providing reliable preventable tire maintenance and repairs.

WHEREAS, The proposed purchase will cost approximately \$100,000 in FY26, utilizing Federal Section 5307 grant funds (Grant # CA-2023-034-02-01).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council of the City of Commerce hereby finds and declares that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and incorporates them herein as findings and as a substantive part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2.</u> City Council approves the purchase of a heavy-duty commercial tire changer and accessory equipment in an amount not to exceed \$100,000, utilizing the State of California, Purchasing Contract No 7-23-99-48-01.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Mayor is authorized to execute this Resolution for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> This Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
