Proclaiming October 6 2018 as
Cerebral Palsy Awareness Day

***WHEREAS**, the full and effective participation of people living with cerebral palsy expresses the inherent dignity and worth of all persons; and*

***WHEREAS**, the City of Commerce is committed to the elimination of all barriers, including physical and attitudinal, that would preclude the participation of all persons in the life of the community; and*

***WHEREAS**, cerebral palsy is the most common physical disability in childhood and is a non-progressive neuro-motor condition affecting 17 million people worldwide; and*

***WHEREAS**, the Commerce community joins hundreds of organizations in more than 50 countries in celebrating and building a global community committed to creating a better world for people living with cerebral palsy and to seeing all people living with cerebral palsy to enjoying "Life Without Limits".*

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY PROCLAIM OCTOBER 6, 2018 AS CEREBRAL PALSY AWARENESS DAY IN THE CITY OF COMMERCE.
