**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE PROJECT MANAGEMENT FUND TO  
SUPPORT THE SUMMER KICK-OFF EVENT AUGMENTATION: PEDAL PALOOZA &  
ALL ABILITIES COLOR FUN RUN**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Commerce supports programs and events that promote community engagement, healthy lifestyles, recreation, and wellness opportunities for residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parks and Recreation Department will host the Summer Kick-Off and All Abilities Color Fun Run event on June 6, 2026, at the Civic Center area; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the 2026 event expansion, the Department proposes incorporating "Pedal Palooza," a community bicycle experience designed to encourage outdoor recreation, safe cycling opportunities, and family-friendly activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed event expansion includes temporary street closures, traffic control measures, entertainment, recreational activities, vendor participation, and related event support services; and

**WHEREAS**, the total estimated additional cost associated with the Pedal Palooza event components is approximately \$12,100; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to appropriate funding from the Project Management Fund to support implementation of the event augmentation and related operational activities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES  
HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein as findings of this Resolution.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council hereby appropriates \$12,100 from the Project Management Fund for the implementation of the Summer Kick-Off Event Augmentation: Pedal Palooza & All Abilities Color Fun Run, including traffic control, recreational activities, entertainment, promotional efforts, and related operational support services.

**SECTION 3.** The Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to amend the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget to reflect the appropriation authorized herein and to establish any necessary expenditure accounts related to the event.

**SECTION 4.** The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the intent of this Resolution.

**SECTION 5.** The Mayor is authorized to execute this Resolution for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.

**SECTION 6.** The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.

**SECTION 7.** This Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
