A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY'S TRANSIT FLEET TO QUALIFY FOR THE CALIFORNIA STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PROGRAM; AND ALLOCATING THE STATE OF GOOD REPAIR PROGRAM FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 FOR SAID PROJECT(S)

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act 2017, establishes the State of Good Repair (SGR) program to fund eligible transit maintenance, rehabilitation and capital project activities that maintain the public transit system in a state of good repair; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce is an eligible project sponsor and may receive and distribute State Transit Assistance – State of Good Repair funds to eligible project sponsors (local agencies) for eligible transit capital projects; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) distributes SGR funds to eligible project sponsors under its regional jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) concurs with and approves the project list for the State of Good Repair Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce authorizes the SGR funds for security equipment and systems (\$33,262).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Commerce hereby finds and declares that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and incorporates them herein as findings and as a substantive part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The City of Commerce approves the project list, including preventative maintenance and spare parts, which are eligible for State of Good Repair funding. It allocates SB1 State of Good Repair Project funding for FY 2026-27 for said project(s).

Section 3. Agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the Certification and Assurances document and applicable statutes, regulations, and guidelines for all SGR-funded transit capital projects.

Section 4. The Director of Transportation is hereby authorized to submit a request for Scheduled Allocation of the SB1 State of Good Repair funds, execute the related grant applications, forms, and agreements, and submit any requisite and supporting documentation for the execution of the same.

Section 5. The Mayor is authorized to execute the Resolution for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
