**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA,  
ESTABLISHING THE APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26**

WHEREAS, Chapter 1205 of the Statutes of 1980, effective January 1, 1981, implemented Article XIII B of the California Constitution, which establishes an annual appropriations limit for local governments; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 111, approved by the voters in 1990, amended Article XIII B to modify the factors used in calculating the annual appropriations limit, allowing local jurisdictions to use a combination of population change and either the change in California per capita personal income or the change in the local assessment roll due to non-residential new construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 2026–27 is established at \$264,440,673 and the appropriation subject to limitation is \$63,866,500 as shown in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**EXHIBIT "A"**  
**ARTICLE XIII-B CALCULATIONS**  
**FOR**  
**FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2026-27**

Per Capita Change = 4.95%<sup>1</sup> (Personal Income)

Population Change = -0.31%

Per Capita converted to a ratio:  $(4.95 + 100) / 100 = 1.0495$

Population converted to a ratio:  $(-0.31 + 100) / 100 = 0.9969$

Calculation of factor for FY 2025-26:  $1.0495 \times 0.9969 = 1.0462$
