A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH FLOCK SAFETY TO MODIFT AND EXPAND SERVCICES FOR MOBILE SECURITY CAMERA TRAILERS

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2025, the City Council of the City of Commerce approved an agreement with Flock Group, Inc. dba Flock Safety, for public safety technology services; and

WHEREAS, staff has evaluated operational needs and identified the need to amend the existing agreement with Flock Group, Inc. dba Flock Safety to expand services to include rental and deployment of mobile security camera trailers; and

WHEREAS, consolidating public safety technology services under the City's existing agreement with Flock Group, Inc. dba Flock Safety will improve operational efficiency, enhance surveillance reliability, and support the City's public safety objectives; and

WHEREAS, the proposed First Amendment will provide mobile security camera trailer rental services for a twelve (12) month term in an amount not to exceed Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000); and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available within the Fiscal Year 2025-26 adopted budget in Traffic Safety funds (Account No. 10-3035-54054), and no additional General Fund appropriation is required; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All of the recitals above are true and correct and incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

Section 2. Approves the First Amendment to the Agreement with Flock Group, Inc. dba Flock Safety to expand services to include mobile security camera trailer rentals for a twelve (12) month period in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 in a form approved by the City Attorney.

Section 3. Authorize the Mayor to execute the Agreement and all related documents and this Resolution for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
