RESOLUTION NO. 22-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR THE FY 2021/22 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO ADVERTISE THE NOTICE INVITING BIDS

WHEREAS, the annual pavement management program will provide for the pavement rehabilitation of streets throughout the City based on the recommendations identified within the City's Pavement Management System (PMS); and

WHEREAS, streets that are recommended to be included in the FY 2021/22 pavement rehabilitation and incidentals include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Bristow Neighborhood Streets including:
 - Sydney Drive from Triggs Street to Noakes Street
 - Duncan Avenue from North Cul-de-sac to Noakes Street
 - McBride Avenue from North Cul-de-sac to Noakes Street
 - McDonnell Avenue from Triggs Street to Dunham Street
 - Dunham Street from Eastern Avenue to Sydney Drive
 - Dunham Street from Duncan Avenue to McDonnell Avenue
 - Noakes Street from Eastern Avenue to McBride Avenue
- 2. Bandini Neighborhood Streets including:
 - Como Street from Astor Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Farrar Street from Astor Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Everington Street from Astor Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Fair Street from Astor Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Gafford Street from Astor Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Harbor Street from Couts Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Quigley Street from Astor Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Kinsie Street from Astor Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Jillson Street from Ransom Street to Couts Avenue
 - Jillson Street from Cowlin Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Leonis Street from Nobel Street to Atlantic Boulevard
 - Nobel Street from Leonis Street to Cowlin Avenue
 - Hepworth Avenue from Astor Avenue to Nobel Street
- 3. Rosini Neighborhood Streets including:
 - Wilma Avenue from Fitzgerald Avenue to Jillson Street
 - Strong Avenue Everington Street to Jillson Street
 - Fitzgerald Avenue from Stevens Place to Harbor Street
 - Everington Street from Atlantic Boulevard to Eastern Avenue
 - Harbor Street from Atlantic Boulevard to Eastern Avenue
- 4. Rosewood Neighborhood Streets including:

- Senta Avenue from Bartmus Street from Jillson Street
- Gaspar Avenue from Bartmus Street from Jillson Street
- Elkgrove Avenue from Bartmus Street from Jillson Street
- Travers Avenue from Bartmus Street from Jillson Street
- Kurt Avenue from Bartmus Street from Jillson Street
- Boris Avenue from Bartmus Street from Jillson Street
- 5. Veterans Neighborhood Streets including:
 - Greenwood Avenue from Bandini Boulevard to Slauson Avenue
 - Todd Avenue from Bandini Boulevard to Wellman Street
 - Wellman Street from Greenwood Avenue to Slauson Avenue
 - Slauson Avenue from 650-feet west of Gage Avenue to Telegraph Road
 - Kuhl Drive from Gage Avenue to Zindell Avenue

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that it is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, Measure AA Funds in the amount of \$3.7 million has been budgeted for the FY 21/22 Pavement Rehabilitation Project, Account #41-5170-57010.14614.

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council approve the construction project plans, specifications, and estimates (PS&E) for this Project and authorize Staff to advertise the Notice Inviting Bids.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Commerce hereby finds and declares that the foregoing recitals are true and correct, and incorporates them herein as findings and as a substantive part of this Resolution.
- **Section 2.** The Project Plans, Specifications, and Estimates (PS&E) for the FY 2021/22 Pavement Rehabilitation Project are hereby approved.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Staff is authorized to proceed with advertisement of the Notice Inviting Bids.
- **Section 4.** Authorize the Mayor to execute the Resolution for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.
- <u>Section 5.</u> This Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
