
Project Description

- PROJECT LOCATED WITHIN THE CITIES OF COMMERCE, HUNTINGTON PARK, BELL, & THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES
- INCLUDES ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS: BICYCLE, PEDESTRIAN AND TRAFFIC CALMING ELEMENTS.
- THE PROJECT IS APPROXIMATELY 6.8 MILES IN LENGTH WITH 2.34 MILES IN THE CITY OF COMMERCE.
- A BUDGET OF \$1.9 MILLION OF THE OVERALL \$6.704 MILLION, WAS ALLOCATED TO THE CITY FOR THE PROJECT.















Alternative A: Class II bike lane westbound, Class IV protected bike lane eastbound












Alternative B: Class I two-way pavement-level bike path on south side













Alternative B1: Class I sidewalk-level shared-use path on south side












Alternative C: Class IV protected bike lanes with north side parking














Alternative D: Class III Bike Route








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Randolph Street at Eastern Avenue, looking west Existing Condition










Randolph Street at Eastern Avenue, looking west Alternative A: Class II bike lane westbound, Class IV protected bike lane eastbound














Randolph Street at Garfield Avenue, looking east Alternative A: Class II bike lane westbound, Class IV protected bike lane eastbound















