## **RESOLUTION NO. 16-114**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH AVOCETTE TO ALLOW FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CITY'S NEW LAND MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City has identified that there is a need to update an outdated land management system (LMS); and

WHEREAS, the City needs to provide for a modern and upgraded LMS that will allow staff to work more efficiently, while providing good customer service; and

WHEREAS, Accela has been the industry leader in designing and delivering productivity and engagement software for over 15 years to help government agencies with their Land Management needs; and

WHEREAS, Accela has the ability to provide the latest technologies that have been made available to other government agencies throughout the nation; and

WHEREAS, the total proposed amount requested to upgrade the City's current Land Management System is \$245,700; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement with Avocette will include a completely redesigned system with the ability to provide real-time information, that will replace a dated static system that is no longer feasible to today's government work environments; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2016 City Council approved \$660,000 in Measure AA Funding as part of the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Capital Improvement Program to upgrade the Land Management Software.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Agreement between the City of Commerce and Avocette Technologies to provide the City with a new Land Management System, is hereby approved. The Mayor is authorized to execute the Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Commerce.
