RESOLUTION NO. 16-113

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA (1) APPROVING CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER AUTHORIZATIONS TO ALL-AMERICAN ASPHALT'S CONTRACT FOR FY 2015-16 ANNUAL PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROGRAM (PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT NO. 2015-15) FOR ADDITIONAL WORK RELATED TO THE TEEN CENTER PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENT, ASTOR AVENUE TRAFFIC CALMING, AND STEVENS PLACE STREET BEAUTIFICATION; AND (2) AUTHORIZING TRANSTECH TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT-RELATED SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City Council approved a budget of \$4,000,000 derived from Measure AA funds for the FY 2015-16 Annual Pavement Rehabilitation Project (the "Project") as part of the adopted Capital Improvement Program (CIP); and

WHEREAS, on April 19, 2016, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for the Project, which includes street reconstruction and rehabilitation consisting of "slurry sealing" and "cold mill & overlay"; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2016, the City Council awarded a contract to All-American Asphalt, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder to, for its low bid of \$2,147,921 and also a construction contingency of \$322,200 was allotted for in case of unforeseen conditions; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2015, per Resolution No. 15-126, the City Council approved an on-call agreement with Transtech Engineers, Inc. (Transtech), which authorizes Transtech to provide inspection, construction management, and project management services for City projects; and

WHEREAS, Public Works staff performed a value engineering analysis and determined that as a result of available additional budget and Project savings, the addition of other pavement related rehabilitation and improvement tasks were warranted; and

WHEREAS, the additional tasks and construction costs are as follows:

1.	Teen Center Parking Improvement →	\$175,000
2.	Astor Avenue Traffic Calming Improvements →	\$ 11,000
3.	Stevens Place Street Beautification →	<u>\$277,500</u>
	Grand Total >	\$463,500 ; and

WHEREAS, accordingly, Staff recommends that the City Council approve the contract change order authorizations for the above three tasks to All-American Asphalt, Inc. and that the City Council authorize Transtech to provide construction and project

management-related services pursuant to its existing "on-call" or staff augmentation contract(s); and

WHEREAS, the above costs are already included in the approved CIP budgets and will not require additional budget allocations due to cost efficiency and savings achieved; and

WHEREAS, approved Project funds are available in Account No. 41-5170-57010.14614 to cover the subject costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY DETERMINE AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The three contract change order authorizations are approved for All-American Asphalt for work related to the FY 2015-16 Annual Pavement Rehabilitation Project that now includes the following tasks: Teen Center Parking Improvement, Astor Avenue Traffic Calming Improvements, and Stevens Place Street Beautification.

<u>Section 2.</u> Transtech is authorized to proceed with inspection, construction management, and project management services for these additional tasks pursuant to its existing "on-call" or staff augmentation contract(s).
