

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF COMMERCE AND BOA ARCHITECTURE, INC.**

The Second Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement (hereinafter "Second Amendment") is made and entered into as of the 18th day of October, 2016 ("Effective Date") by and between the City of Commerce, a public body of the State of California ("City") and BOA Architecture, Inc., a California corporation ("Consultant").

WITNESSETH

This Second Amendment is made with reference to the following facts:

- A. On June 15, 2015, the City and Consultant entered into an Agreement for the design of the Senior Center – Rehabilitation and ADA Improvement Project for a 12 month period with the option to extend the Agreement at the City's discretion.
- B. On April 19, 2016, the City and Consultant entered into a First Amendment for additional scope of work related to ADA compliance and a budget of \$29,800 for additional design services.
- C. The parties hereto mutually desire to enter into a Second Amendment to the Agreement in the manner hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, conditions and covenants herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Term of Agreement:

Pursuant to provisions in Section 2 ("Term") of the Agreement:

- A. The parties hereto agree to extend the term of the agreement an additional 12 months from the effective date to expire on October 18, 2017.
