

RESOLUTION NO. 16-129

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA: (1) APPROVING THE BID PACKAGE AND AUTHORIZES STAFF TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE CITYWIDE BUS SHELTER BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT (PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT NO. 2016-29) AND (2) ADOPTING A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION RELATED TO THIS WORK**

WHEREAS, as part of Measure AA funding requirements, 2.5% of the funding is to be used for City beautification activities and projects; and

WHEREAS, existing bus shelters in the City are various shades of green/teal, brown, or black; and

WHEREAS, to provide aesthetic uniformity throughout the City and to strengthen the City's future branding efforts, as recommended the Beautification Committee, staff recommends that the all existing bus shelters be painted black to match the recently completed work on Washington Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, this color palette is consistent with the Washington Boulevard project which is consistent with the branding effort for the City; and

WHEREAS, the Citywide Bus Shelter Beautification Project (Public Works Project No. 2016-29) (Project) will provide for the re-painting of existing bus shelters that are installed throughout the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Notice of Exemption per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to 14 California Code of Regulations § 15301 as a Class 1 categorical exemption (Existing Facilities), is hereby approved and adopted.

Section 2. The bid package for the Citywide Bus Shelter Beautification Project (Public Works Project No. 2016-29) is hereby approved. City staff is authorized to advertise for bids for the Project.
