RECOMMENDATION:

The Parks & Recreation Department is respectfully requesting sponsorship from the City Council for the Commerce Crush Volleyball Teams to attend the Las Vegas Junior National Qualifier tournament April 7-9, 2017 in Las Vegas, Nevada.

RELATIONSHIP TO STRATEGIC GOALS:

This agenda item relates to the 2016 Strategic Plan Goal, Community Quality of Life and Guiding Principle #4 - Support and evaluate community services, programs and events that promote healthy and quality lifestyles for our residents. Enhance public safety and social services through innovative programs that meet the needs of the residential and business communities.

ANALYSIS/BACKGROUND:

The Commerce Crush Volleyball Team's goal is to participate in the 2017 Junior Nationals. In order to attend this event, the teams must participate in the Las Vegas Junior National Qualifier Tournament April 7-9, 2017. If approved, the following Crush Volleyball teams will attend: 13u, 14u, 15u and 16u.

In order for the teams to participate in this qualifier tournament, the Department of Parks & Recreation is requesting additional funding in the amount of \$7,000.00 to cover the cost of registration, lodging and per diem.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Should the City Council approve this request for sponsorship, a total of \$7,000.00 will need to be appropriated (staff will present this item for formal funding approval as part of the mid-year report scheduled for February 21, 2017) and allocated to the respective accounts.
