RESOLUTION NO. 17-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, FOR UTILITY BOX ART BEAUTIFICATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, as part of Measure AA funding requirements, 2.5% of the funding is to be used for City beautification activities and projects; and

WHEREAS, existing City maintained/owned utility boxes in the City have no art components; and

WHEREAS, to provide public art and beautification throughout the City and to strengthen the future branding efforts of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Beautification Committee Selection of artwork to be installed at various city owned signal utility cabinets, is hereby approved; and

<u>Section 2</u>. The Parks and Recreation Department is authorized to wash and prime city owned signal utility cabinets before the artist begins work, and install anti-graffiti coating on completed artwork; and

<u>Section 3</u>. The Finance Department is authorized to issue a purchase order for each selected artist and artwork in the amount of \$800 each, with 50% being paid before the artwork is to begin and the remainder after completion.
