### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Ms. Connie Ochoa and Ms. Alice Sterling were the first employees assigned to the Preschool & Tiny Tot Program. As early childhood instructors, they assisted in creating the foundation of what the City's Preschool and Tiny Tot program is today.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

The coordination of the ceremonies and purchase the dedication plaques will cost approximately \$2,000. This amount will be absorbed as part of this year's Parks & Recreation budget.
