SUBJECT: A Proclamation to Proclaim April 2018 as "Sexual Assault Awareness

Month" and April 25, 2018 as "Denim Day"

MEETING DATE: April 3, 2018

RECOMMENDATION:

City staff recommends that the City Council approve a proclamation to proclaim April 2018 as "Sexual Assault Awareness Month" and April 25, 2018 as "Denim Day."

ANALYSIS:

Peace Over Violence is asking government agencies to join them in supporting Sexual Assault Awareness Month in April 2018 and Denim Day on April 25, 2018. This campaign protests an Italian Supreme Court Decision to overturn a rape conviction because the victim wore jeans. It draws attention to the fact that rape and sexual assault remain a serious issue in society. The City Council strongly supports efforts to educate the community about the true impact of rape and sexual violence. City staff will place posters at City facilities and encourage City staff to wear denim on April 25, 2018. Informational brochures on the subject will be made available.

This activity may be carried out without additional impact on the current operating budget.
