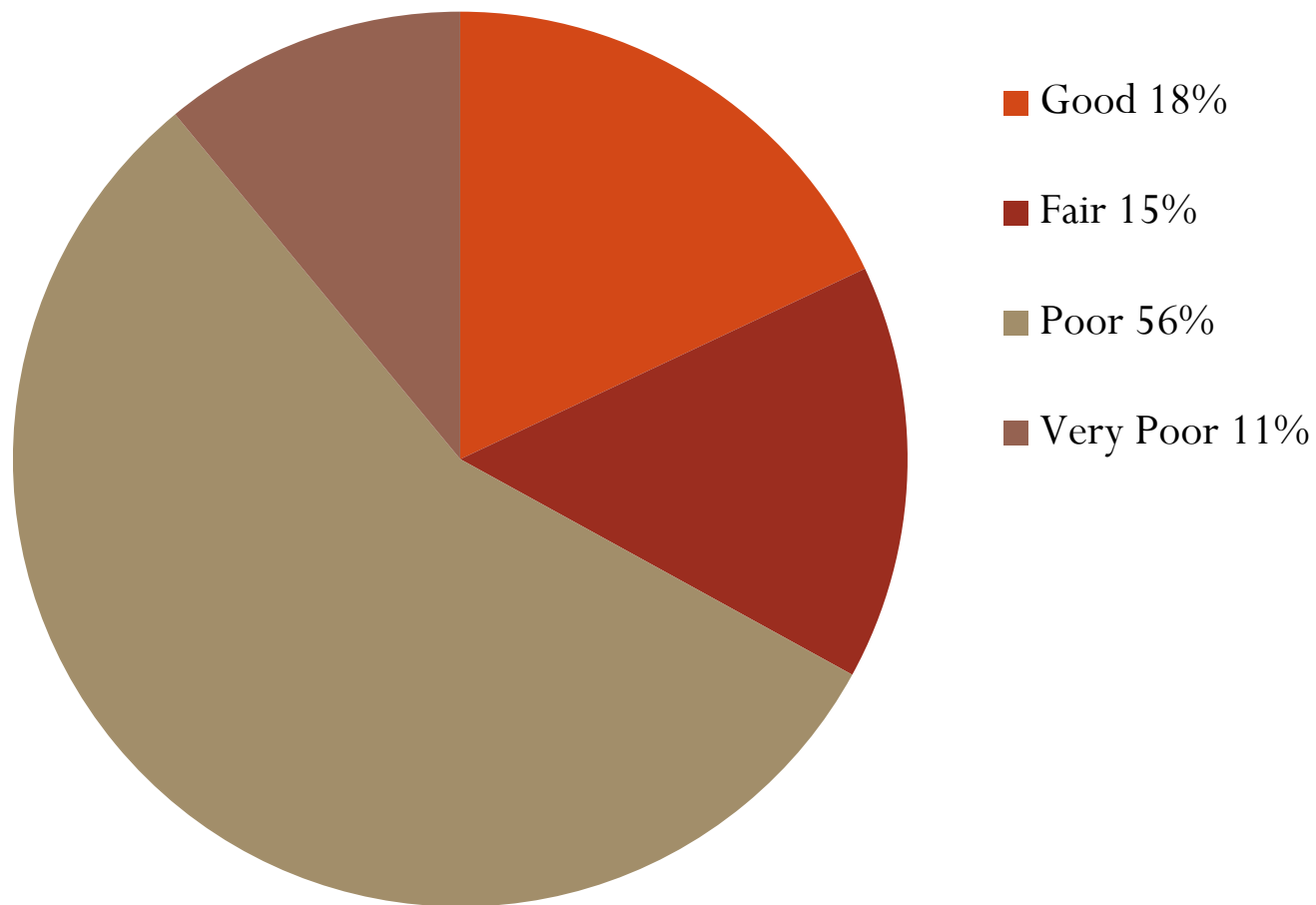
- 3 snack bars (Harbor, McDonnell, Zindell)

Maintenance Needs –

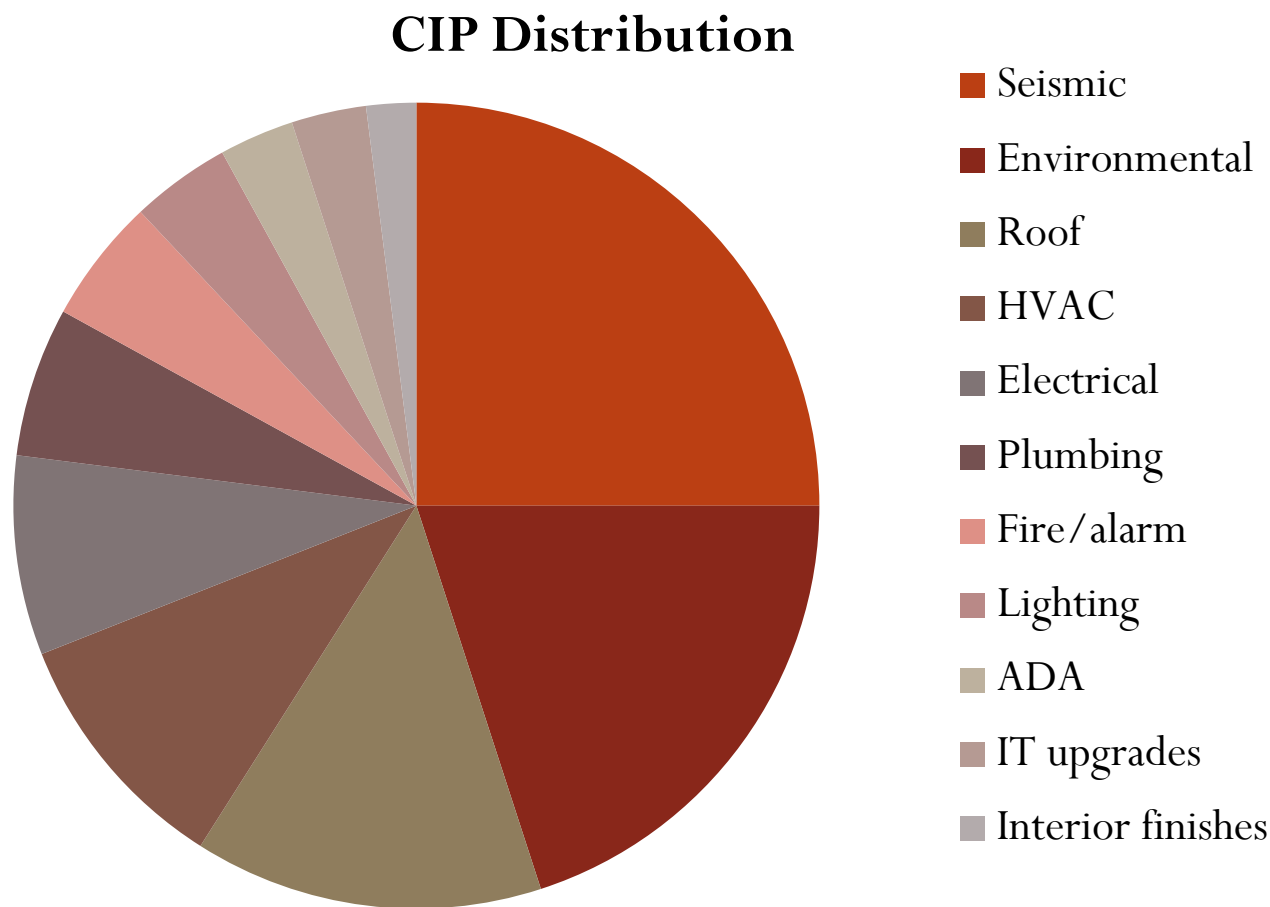
Conducted by in-house Facilities Maintenance Division,
IT Division and/or contractor

- HVAC (15-25 year life cycle)
- Roofing (15 year life cycle – patch and repair as needed)
- Electrical (troubleshooting electrical problems – upgrade as needed)
- Plumbing (troubleshooting electrical problems – upgrade as needed)
- Lighting (converting all facility lighting to LED)
- Painting (Exterior – every 5 years, Interior – every year)
- Security system/fire alarm (5 year service contract – repair and upgrade as needed)
- Network/camera upgrades (IT)
- Aquatic Center (specialized facility for maintenance of all of the above with major repairs contracted out)

Proposed Initial 5-Year Improvements

Replacement Item	Cost	Cost Spread
Veteran's Park	TBD	Year one
Aquatic Center – replace HVAC unit AHU-R1, increase size and extend ductwork for spectator spot cooling	\$800,000	
Aquatic Center – replace HVAC units 2 and 3	\$700,000	Year two
General Facilities Improvements – to be determined during budget preparation for FY 18/19	\$4,500,000	
Aquatic Center – replace dehumidifier units (2), add rollup doors and storage	\$4,000,000	Year three
General Facilities Improvements	\$1,200,000	
City Hall – replace roof, HVAC, and complete environmental abatement	\$5,000,000	Year four
Bristow Park Facility	\$3,000,000	Year five
