

RESOLUTION NO. 17-78

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE,  
CALIFORNIA, FOR (1) AWARD CONSTRUCTION TO CALPROMAX  
ENGINEERING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$719,220 (2) AUTHORIZE 10%  
CONTINGENCY (3) AUTHORIZE TRANSTECH ENGINEERS, INC. TO  
PROCEED WITH CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES IN THE  
AMOUNT OF \$79,114 (NOT TO EXCEED 10% OF THE TOTAL PROJECT  
COST)**

WHEREAS, project funding was approved through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Cycle 4 Call for Applications in 2010; and,

WHEREAS, the City received \$503,400.00 in federal grant funds with a local match requirement of \$55,934.00; and

WHEREAS, the project will install emergency vehicle pre-emption systems, video detection cameras on mast arms, construct missing sidewalks and curb ramps as well as provide standard grade crossing signage, pavement markings, as well as provide left-turn phasing at Washington Boulevard and Yates Avenue as well as at Garfield Avenue and Yates Avenue to increase safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Construction Contract with Calpromax Engineering, Inc. is hereby approved. The Mayor is authorized to execute the Contract for and on behalf of the City. A contingency in the amount of 10% of the awarded contract amount is hereby approved.

Section 2. Transtech Engineering, Inc. is authorized to proceed with necessary project management, funds management, construction management, construction inspection, and administration in an amount not to exceed 10% of the project cost (\$79,114), per their existing On-Call General Civil Engineer Services Contract, dated February 2, 2016.
