SUBJECT: A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Commerce, California, Approving Memorandum of Understanding with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA) for Proposition C-5% Transit Security Funds

RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend approval of the Memorandum of Understanding MOU.PC18COM1 for Proposition C 5% Transit Security Funds.

MOTION:

Approve the Resolution and assign the number next in order.

BACKGROUND:

On November 6, 1990, the voters of the County of Los Angeles approved by majority Proposition C, an ordinance establishing a one-half percent sales tax for public transit purposes. MOU.PC17COM1 states that 5% of the Proposition C funds are to be used to improve and expand rail and bus security.

LACMTA is the agency responsible for administering these funds. The City's share of the program funding for FY 2018 is \$40,716. This MOU is in effect from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This activity can be carried out without additional impact on the current operating budget.

RELATIONSHIP TO THE 2016 STRATEGIC GOALS:

This agenda item relates to the 2016 strategic planning goal: "Grow revenues to ensure all expenses are being met so that we can remain fiscally responsible and continue to provide services to the residents," as this subsidy will assist in mitigating Transportation's capital costs for the City.
