SUBJECT: Committee and Commission Appointments

MEETING DATE: September 5, 2017

RECOMMENDATION:

Make the appropriate appointments or re-appointments.

ANALYSIS:

Pursuant to Resolution No. 14-115, each Councilmember makes one appointment to the various Commissions and Committees of the City, with the terms of office of each appointee being for a period not to exceed two years, expiring at the next General Municipal Election. The term of office shall continue until the appointment and qualification of successor appointees. The entire Council makes appointments of any sixth or more members, and industrial members.

It is recommended that appointments be made to the following: Commission and Committees: Traffic Commission, Library Commission, Senior Citizens Commission, Measure AA Advisory Committee, I-710 Local Advisory Committee, and other Commission & Committees as necessary.

Measure AA Advisory Committee: Two of the Committee members represent business that are located in the City. The City Council appoints or reappoints the business representative members. Currently Jon Reno and Steve Craig are members of the Measure AA Advisory Committee.

The City Council also appoints one ex officio members who represents the City of Commerce Employee Association. The ex officio member participates in discussion on matters before the Committee, but does not have voting rights. Ralph Vivero is currently an ex-officio.

Community Union Pacific Railroad Task Force: This task force was created a while ago by the City Council, however, these task force appointments were never fully finalized. Each Councilmember will make one appointment for the period not to exceed two years.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This activity can be carried out without additional impact on the current operating budget.
