SUBJECT: APPOINTEMNT OF COUNCILMEMBERS TO THE AD HOC

RECOMMENDATION:

Appoint two councilmembers to the Ad Hoc Committee to work with staff to study, evaluate and recommend alternatives for the Veterans Park Recreation Center.

ANALYSIS:

In late July, Council approved funding a study for IDS consultants to evaluate various alternatives for Veterans Park Recreation Center. IDS has now completed its draft study. They also provided recommendations for the interim use of the gym area although it was not included in their original scope. At this time, the study is completed and staff is requesting that an Ad Hoc Committee be formed to work with staff to study the alternatives and make a recommendation to Council for the future of the Veterans Park Recreation Center.
