SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH RNL DESIGN FOR ARCHITECTURE AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR A CONCEPTUAL DESIGN AND FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT'S

DISPATCH OFFICE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

MEETING DATE: September 19, 2017

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approve Agreement with RNL Design for professional architecture and engineering services for a conceptual design and feasibility study for Transportation department's dispatch office improvement project.

RELATIONSHIP TO STRATEGIC GOALS:

This agenda item relates to the 2016 Strategic Plan - Goal #6: "Enhance Quality of Life Goal"; as this project increases office space for transit operations; which improves operational efficiency and helps maximize staff time and resources.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Commerce has a \$444,000 grant from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), for the expansion and renovation of the dispatch and office areas within the transportation facility. This project has also been approved by Metro and included as part of the Federal Transportation Improvement Plan (Project ID # LA061295).

ANALYSIS:

The scope of work includes the following deliverables:

- Prepare conceptual floor plan with conceptual furniture layout, roof plan, and ceiling plan;
- Prepare a narrative describing the structural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, fire alarm, and fire protection systems for the new spaces;
- Prepare conceptual site plan and narrative of utilities and drainage systems;
- Narrative describing the code restrictions, limitations, and requirements for the proposed improvements; and

• The contents of the above information shall be included in a Request for Proposal (RFP) to obtain design and build services for the proposed facility modifications.

The City received three professional architecture and engineering services quotes for the transportation department's dispatch office improvement project.

The three quotes are as follows:

RNL Design submitted the most responsible and qualified quote. RNL is a global design firm that integrates design thinkers in architecture, landscape, urban and interior design spanning scales, geographies, and disciplines to find elegant solutions to diverse and complex challenges.

RNL Design is the architecture firm on record, who was hired by the City in 1993 to design the existing transportation maintenance facility located at 5555 Jillson Street, Commerce, CA, 90040.

FISCAL IMPACT

This project shall be funded using Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Grant Funds for the expansion and renovation of the dispatch and office areas within the transportation facility.
