#### **March Options**

**Option 1.** Beginning March 2022, synchronize with statewide election in March of each even-numbered year, **increasing** City officeholder terms of office by 9 months.

<u>Option 2.</u> Beginning March 2020, synchronize with statewide election in March of each even-numbered year, **increasing** City officeholder terms of office by 9 months (for those elected in 2015).

Should the City Council choose the option of synchronizing in March 2020, it needs to be taken into account that the primary election administered by the Los Angeles County will be at the same time on the same day, and the City would be in the same situation as in the last election of 2017 (two ballots, two polling places on the same day, etc). If this option selected, it would be recommended to consolidate with the County for the next election.

### **November Options**

**Option 3.** Beginning <u>November 2018</u>, synchronize with statewide elections in November of each even-numbered year, **reducing** Officeholder terms of office by 7 months.

**Option 4.** Beginning <u>November 2020</u>, synchronize with statewide elections in November of each even-numbered year for 2 Councilmembers, **reducing** Officeholder terms of office by 7 months. Please note, election will be held June 2019 for three officeholders, and their term would be reduced by 7 months.

# Option 6.

**Step 1.** Beginning **March 2022**, synchronize with statewide election in March of each even-numbered year, **increasing** City officeholder terms of office by 9 months.

**Step 2. In 2026** move the date of election from March to November, increasing City officeholder terms of office by 5 months in order to increase voter turnout (November election average voter turnout is 50% and March primary election voter turnout is 21%).
