

RESOLUTION NO. 17-119

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE,
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING PURCHASES WITH PUBLIC
TRANSPORTATION MODERNIZATION, IMPROVEMENT, AND SERVICE
ENHANCEMENT ACCOUNT BOND PROGRAM (PTMISEA) FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce is an eligible project sponsor and may receive state funding from the Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) now or sometime in the future for transit projects; and

WHEREAS, the statutes related to state-funded transit projects require a local or regional implementing agency to abide by various regulations; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 88 (2007) named the Department of Transportation (Department) as the administrative agency for the PTMISEA; and

WHEREAS, the Department has developed guidelines for the purpose of administering and distributing PTMISEA funds to eligible project sponsors (local agencies); and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce has a remaining balance of \$338,376 Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce shall use these funds towards the purchase of 1) Bus Stop Signage Reproduction Project (\$180,000); 2) Purchase of a Portable Heavy Duty Hydraulic Bus Lift System (\$51,544); and 3) Replace the Shop Floor in the Transportation Maintenance Facility (\$106,832).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Commerce hereby approves the purchases outlined above, to be funded through the PTMISEA bond program.
