SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING STATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE CALIFORNIA

GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Resolution authorizing staff to execute documents for the purpose of obtaining assistance from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services.

BACKGROUND:

For Fiscal Year 2016-17, the City of Commerce shall receive \$17,074 from the California Transit Security Grant Program. This program, created as part of the voter approved Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality and Port Security Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 1B), provides funding for transit safety and security capital improvements. The proposed resolution appoints agents authorized to execute any actions necessary for each application.

ANALYSIS:

California Transit Security Grant Program funds shall be used to install onboard entrance door monitoring systems throughout the transit fleet. The new system will also allow video to be downloaded to the City's server wirelessly.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed activity will be paid for using the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, Prop 1B - Transit Security Funds and will not have an impact to the City's General Fund.

This agenda item relates to the 2016 strategic planning goal: "review and update services and activities to increase efficiency," as this transit security subsidy will assist in mitigating transportation's operating and capital costs for the City.
