SUBJECT: REPORT ON RECOVERED COSTS

MEETING DATE: January 16, 2018

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council receive the report by the Public Works and Development Services Department on recovered costs.

ANALYSIS:

During the current fiscal year, staff has recovered \$33,149.26 from three sources – damage to City property, shared cost from fence installation, and development cost as part of a city resolution. Below are the details of the costs recovery:

The recovered amounts are deposited to the City's revenue account, account number 10-7100-39600. The recovered amounts provide full and/or partial recovery of the department's operational expenses.
