

RESOLUTION NO. 18-06

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMMERCE
APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE LOS ANGELES
HOMELESS SERVICES AUTHORITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OPT-IN PROGRAM FOR
THE 2018-2020 GREATER LOS ANGELES HOMELESS COUNT; AND AUTHORIZATION TO
EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

WHEREAS, The Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority's (LAHSA) primary goal is to help homeless persons find permanent housing; and

WHEREAS, the LAHSA coordinates a annual point-in-time street count of homeless persons in the Los Angeles County; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count will provide LAHSA with data related to the size and scope of homelessness throughout Los Angeles County; and

WHEREAS, the data collected from the Homeless Count will allow LAHSA to assess what areas are in greater need and how homeless persons can best be served;

WHEREAS, participation by the City of Commerce in the Homeless Count will allow the City to use the 2018-2020 Homeless Count methodology to obtain a reliable estimate of the unsheltered homeless population within the City; and

WHEREAS, participation by the City of Commerce will aid the City's efforts to plan for future measures to address local homelessness in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce desires to participate in the 2018-2020 Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Commerce and the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority to participate in the Opt-In Program for the 2018-2020 Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute the Memorandum of Understanding approved herein on behalf of the City.
