SUBJECT: Preserving Local History Project

RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

Currently, there are hundreds of slides, photographs, newspaper clippings and other historical documents that are in great need of preservation. While the City of Commerce is only 67 years old, there is a rich history that includes both residents and the business community.

Currently, these documents are housed in different locations including the warehouse where the conditions for storage are less than optimal. It is the Library's desire to begin to digitize and capture the local history of the City of Commerce for all to enjoy. The Library's Preserving Local History Project would evaluate the existing materials and assess them to see what can be saved for the project. The Library would then create a plan in phases to make the materials searchable and accessible to the public online and in person at the Rosewood Main Library.
