

RESOLUTION NO. 18-15

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE TO AWARD CONSTRUCTION, CMCI AND GEOTECHNICAL CONTRACTS TO PROCEED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE FY 2017-18 ANNUAL PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2017, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for the Pavement Rehabilitation Program FY 2017-18 and authorized staff to advertise the project for bid;

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2017, the City Council approved the FY 2017-18 CIP Budget, which included approval of the Annual Street Rehabilitation Program in the amount of \$2,500,000 for the current fiscal year. In total there is \$5,000,000 budgeted for the FY 2017-18 Annual Street Rehabilitation Program which includes FY 2016-17 CIP budget amount and FY 2017-18 CIP budget amount approvals for this project.;

WHEREAS, the proposed Project is a project subject to CEQA. Staff has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that it is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section(s) 15302: Replacement or reconstruction; (c) Replacement or reconstruction of existing utility and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity;

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder for the construction contract is Excel Paving Company in the amount of \$3,736,161;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approve a construction contract with Excel Paving Company for the FY 2017-18 Annual Pavement Rehabilitation Program, in the amount of \$3,736,161; and,

Section 2. Authorizes Transtech Engineers, Inc. to proceed with Construction Management and Inspection Services, in the amount of \$286,975, pursuant to their existing agreement for consultant services; and,

Section 3. Authorizes Geo-Advantec, Inc. to proceed with Geotechnical Investigation and Material Testing Services in an amount of \$61,187, pursuant to their existing agreement for consultant services; and,

Section 4. Authorizes construction contingency in the amount of \$373,616 (10%) for unforeseen conditions
