

RESOLUTION NO. 18-37

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO ACCEPT AS COMPLETE THE
MALT AVENUE STREET RACING MITIGATION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2016, the Traffic Commission approved implementing mitigation measures through a “pilot program” to discourage street racing along Malt Avenue from Garfield Avenue to Telegraph Road; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2017, the City Council approved the project plans and specifications for the Malt Avenue Street Racing Mitigation Improvement Project and directed staff to advertise for bids; and

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2017, the City Council awarded the construction contract to PALP, Inc. *dba* Excel Paving Company (Excel Paving), in the amount of \$106,540; and

WHEREAS the final cost for the construction work completed by Excel Paving is \$106,540 that is within the approved contract amount; and

WHEREAS the project is to be accepted as complete.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approve and adopt a Resolution accepting the work as complete the Malt Avenue Street Racing Mitigation Improvement Project.
