SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, EXERCISING THE CITY'S OPTION TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT WITH REMIX SOFTWARE INCORPORATED FOR THE PURCHASE OF A TRANSIT PLANNING SOFTWARE SYSTEM FOR ONE YEAR

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Council will consider for adoption a Resolution exercising the City's option to extend the Agreement with Remix Software, Inc. for the purchase of a transit planning software system for one year.

BACKGROUND:

On March 7, 2017, City Council approved an open Request for Proposal (RFP) process for the purchase of a transit planning software system. The RFP was posted and advertised for thirty (30) days, which resulted in one proposer, Remix Software, Inc. Staff completed a comprehensive web search and reviewed other software dedicated to transit service. City staff was not able to find other software with the same features as Remix Software, Inc.

Staff consulted with other transit agencies who posted RFP's for transit planning software systems (Torrance Transit, River City Transit, North County Transportation District, and Butler County Regional Transportation Authority) and each of them confirmed that they only received one bid as well; which resulted in a sole source procurement with Remix for the same reasons noted above.

On May 8, 2017, City Council approved an Agreement with Remix Software, Inc. for the purchase of a transit planning software system. The Agreement includes two one-year options to extend the Agreement one-year that that City has the discretion to exercise.

ANALYSIS:

The transit planning software system is a web-based transit planning software platform that provides rapid route design, import/analysis/modification of existing transit routes, demographics analysis, operating costs calculations, travel time visualizations, and Title VI

analysis into a single integrated platform for transit planning. It is in the City's best interest to take advantage of opportunities to increase staff efficiency and keep up-to-date with emerging technology.

Remix's software is a tool for streamlining the City's transit service planning process by providing staff with the unprecedented ability to complete core functions of the service planning workflow with one single tool. City staff will be able to import existing route and schedule data via GTFS (the standard feed for transit data), create quick routing and scheduling scenarios through geospatial map overlays. City staff will be able to compute and export instant and accurate cost and resource utilization estimates, with the ability to easily share this information both internally and in the public communication process, all in a single web-based application that staff can access and use with limited training.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. Move to approve recommendation.
2. Provide staff with further direction.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This project shall be paid out of the State Funded Municipal Operator Service Improvement Program (MOSIP), Account #57-8331-55051.14097. As such, this project will not have an impact to the City's operating budget.

The City's annual allocation of MOSIP funds is \$83,458.
