## **RESOLUTION NO. 18-48**

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MIG PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES, PURSUANT TO AN EXISTING ON-CALL SERVICES AGREEMENT, TO CONDUCT THE APPROPRIATE ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) FOR A PROPOSED PROJECT AT 6300 TELEGRAPH ROAD

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a resolution approving professional services agreements and establishing an eligibility list for various on-call professional services which includes MIG Planning and Environmental Management Services; and

WHEREAS, Staff is in the process of reviewing a development application to allow the construction of a new 82,687 square foot building with 58 surface parking spaces at 6300 Telegraph Road and in the City's Light Industrial (M-1) zone; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is subject to environmental analysis pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), which requires the potential impacts of the project to be properly analyzed; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council authorize MIG Planning and Environmental Management Services, pursuant to an existing on-call services agreement, to conduct the necessary CEQA environmental analysis, including the preparation of a traffic study, for the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the cost for completing the subject work will be \$40,450, as described in the attached proposal. Staff is also requesting a ten percent contingency to bring the total to \$44,495.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. MIG Planning and Environmental Management Services. is hereby authorized to conduct and prepare the appropriate analysis as outlined in their proposed approach and scope (Exhibit A) at a cost of \$40,450 plus a ten percent contingency, for a total of \$44,495.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to execute the agreement for and on behalf of the City.
