**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE,
CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES
PROBATION DEPARTMENT AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE A PREVENTION AND
INTERVENTION PROGRAM (PIP) FOR SEPTEMBER 1, 2018 – AUGUST 31, 2019**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce engages the Los Angeles County Probation Department to provide a Prevention and Intervention Program (PIP); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide probation prevention and intervention services to assist in reducing incidents of truancy, delinquency and other serious behavioral problems, and monitoring of adults on probation; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement between City of Commerce and L.A. County Probation Department has been in existence since 1987; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Probation Officer has been delegated authority by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors to negotiate and sign agreements to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in a joint effort with the county; and

WHEREAS, the current Agreement entered into for Fiscal Year 2017/18 will expire on August 31, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES, DECLARES AND DETERMINES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The County of Los Angeles Probation Department Agreement to Provide a Prevention and Intervention Program (PIP) for September 1, 2018 – August 31, 2019, at a cost of \$87,000 plus any adjustments to salary, employee benefits and/or overhead rates approved by the Board of Supervisors during the fiscal year, is hereby approved with respect to the level of services as approved by the City Council during its consideration of the 2018-2019 fiscal year budget in July 2018. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City.
