A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE APPROVING TWO MEMORANDUMS OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE LOS ANGELES REGIONAL FOOD BANK TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce has participated in the distribution of canned and dry food to qualifying low income residents through the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank for twenty-six years and would like to continue to service children in the summer months through the Summer Food Service Program; and

WHEREAS, the food is provided by the United States Department of Agriculture to the Food Bank who then provides them to the City, at no cost; and

WHEREAS, the Summer Food Service Program is a federally funded program that fills the nutrition gap when students are not in school; and

WHEREAS, the program ensures that children and qualifying young adults from the City of Commerce, East LA and surrounding areas receive nutritious meals during the summer months; and

WHEREAS, the distribution sites have been identified as Bristow Library and Veteran's Park; and

WHEREAS, in order to participate in the Summer Food Service Program, the City must enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank for each distribution site.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Commerce and the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank is hereby approved. The Mayor is authorized to execute the Agreement for and on behalf of the city of Commerce.
