The key features of this proposal include the following:

- New 96-gallon Trash and Recycling carts for all residents
- Complete fleet of CNG trucks to service the City of Commerce
- On-call SHARPS container delivery to residents
- Updated Residential Contract
- A contract extension of ten (10) years with a self-renewing clause

CalMet will continue to provide the following additional services:

- Free on-call pick up of large items from residents
- Free on-call pick up of electronic waste from residents
- Free City Services worth over \$11,000 per month

We would also like the City's consideration to include all Multi-family units as part of the residential contract. CalMet can ensure compliance with AB341 mandate of recycling for all Multi-family units of five or more. We have our own MRF facility with guaranteed capacity for Commerce residential waste stream and are in the process of building a new \$35 million state of art MRF facility. As the recycling mandates increase in the State (up to 75% diversion in coming years), CalMet would guarantee compliance for the entire residential sector. We view this proposal as a working document and look forward to collaborating with City Staff on a final proposal.
