

REPORT TO AD-HOC COMMITTEE ROSINI COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS

The following is a summary of results from the recent Rosini Community survey. City of Commerce staff conducted the survey in two (2) phases: *i*) mail-out to the residents and businesses with a response deadline of May 10, 2018, and *ii*) door-to-door canvassing on June 2, 2018 of those residents who did not respond to the original mailed-out survey in order to effectuate a more comprehensive survey sample.

i) Results of the initial mail-out of the Rosini Community survey (initial response deadline of May 10, 2018):

Staff extended the deadline an extra week until May 17, 2018. This gave the community over three (3) weeks to respond to the survey.

Only twenty-two (22) households answered the initial community survey. The following is a breakdown of the responses:

- 7 households responded “Maintain AS-IS” → 32% of respondents
- 7 households responded “Implement permit parking” → 32% of respondents
- 4 households responded “Implement driveway permit parking” → 18% of respondents
- 3 households gave vague and unclear responses → 13.5% of respondents
- 1 household requested potholes in the alley to be repaired → 4.5% of respondents

ii) Results of the door-to-door canvassing of the Rosini Community survey (conducted on June 2, 2018):

Community Service Officers (CSO’s) from the Public Safety Division visited and canvassed door-to-door sixty-eight (68) households that did **not** mail in their Rosini Community surveys.

Of the sixty-eight (68) that were canvassed, only forty-three (43) responded and submitted a completed survey. The remaining twenty-five (25) were **not** at home.

The following is a breakdown of the responses:

- 12 responded “Maintain AS-IS” → 28% of respondents
- 10 responded “Implement permit parking” → 23% of respondents
- 3 responded “Implement driveway permit parking” → 7% of respondents
- 12 responded “Install signs” → 28% of respondents
- 1 responded “Install fence” → 2% of respondents
- 5 responded “Implement other action” → 12% of respondents

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Total Results from i) and ii) above:

Adding the responses from the initial mail-out and with the door-to-door canvassing produces a total response of **65** households (22 from the mail-out plus 43 from the door-to-door canvassing).

The final comprehensive breakdown of the responses is as follows:

- 19 responded “Maintain AS-IS” → 29% of respondents
- 17 responded “Implement permit parking” → 26% of respondents
- 7 responded “Implement driveway permit parking” → 11% of respondents
- 12 responded “Install signs” → 18% of respondents
- 1 responded “Install fence” → 1.5% of respondents
- 5 responded “Implement other action” → 8% of respondents
- 3 households gave vague and unclear responses → 5% of respondents
- 1 household requested potholes in the alley to be repaired → 1.5% of respondents
