A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, FOR AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT TWO PROJECTS FOR THE NEXT ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION GRANT CYCLE 4

WHEREAS, it is expected that as part of Federal funding, State SB1and SHA funding, some \$440 million will be available for Active Transportation grant funds; and

WHEREAS, due to population based formulas, City of Commerce does not get nearly its fair share back from these funds, staff is working towards submitting grant requests to bring some benefits back to the City; and

WHEREAS, Public Works and Development Services staff is preparing the grant documents and is proposing to submit for two projects:

- Slauson Avenue pedestrian connectivity from Gage to Telegraph
- Rosewood Neighborhood Rail to Trail connectivity project

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Authorize staff to submit two projects for the next Active Transportation Program Cycle 4.
