RESOLUTION NO. 18-___

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS AND STOP BAR MARKINGS ALONG TRIGGS STREET AT THE INTERSECTION OF TRIGGS STREET AND DUNCAN AVENUE

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 21351 and Commerce Municipal Code (CMC) Sections 10.20.010 and 10.32.010 authorize the City of Commerce (City) to place and maintain official traffic control devices within the City and also that the City Council by way of ordinance or resolution may install or erect STOP signs; and

WHEREAS, Staff completed a STOP warrant analysis consistent with the California Manual on Traffic Control Devices (CA MUTCD) for the intersection of Triggs Street and Duncan Avenue and presented its findings to the Traffic Commission on August 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, during its regularly scheduled meeting on August 8, 2018, the Traffic Commission recommended that STOP signs and STOP bar markings be installed along Triggs Street at Duncan Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the STOP signs and STOP bar markings along Triggs Street at Duncan Avenue is based on engineering judgment in controlling vehicular traffic movements along Triggs Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Per CVC Sections 21351 & 21355 and per CMC Sections 10.20.010 & 10.32.010, the City is authorized to place and maintain official traffic control devices, such as STOP signs, within the City and also that the City Council by way of ordinance or resolution, through the authority of the City Administrator, may install or erect STOP signs.

<u>Section 2.</u> STOP signs and STOP bar markings shall be installed along Triggs Street at the intersection of Duncan Avenue, consistent with the appropriate code sections of the CVC, CMC, and the CA MUTCD.
