RESOLUTION NO. 18-___

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE REMOVAL OF THE WHITE EDGELINE TRAFFIC CALMING STREET MARKINGS, EXCEPT FOR THE YELLOW CENTERLINE, ALONG TRIGGS STREET FROM MARIANNA AVENUE TO McDONNELL AVENUE

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code (CVC) Section 21459 and Commerce Municipal Code (CMC) Sections 10.20.050 and 10.20.060 authorize the City Administrator to mark center lines and lane lines upon the surface of the roadway and to place and maintain distinctive roadway markings; and

WHEREAS, during its regularly scheduled meeting on August 8, 2018, the Traffic Commission recommended that the white edgeline traffic calming street markings, except for the yellow centerline, along Triggs Street be removed from Marianna Avenue to McDonnell Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the removal of the traffic calming street markings is based on engineering judgment, and that this action does not adversely affect pedestrian and traffic safety in the surrounding area.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Per CVC Section 21459 and per CMC Sections 10.20.050 & 10.32.060, the City Administrator is authorized to mark center lines and lane lines upon the surface of the roadway and to place and maintain distinctive roadway markings.

<u>Section 2.</u> The white edgeline traffic calming street markings, except for the yellow centerline, along Triggs Street shall be removed from Marianna Avenue to McDonnell Avenue.
